Key Items since October ExCom



- 21 October – Attended Synapse Conference to find additional sponsors and exhibitors
- 27-28 October – Attended IEEE Convene in Boston
- 1 November – Hardware rules finalized
- 3 November – Local Organizing Committee Meeting
- 7 November – Gained contact with UCF Programming Team, scheduling meeting for 16 November
- 9 November – Registration active

Logistics Updates



- \$50,000 deposit is “on hold” until at least 90 days prior to event (January 12, 2022) when credit check will be run by the property
- Requested contract amendment to reflect updated deposit schedule, awaiting amendment from property
- -\$5,000 balance with NextGen banking has been corrected

- **Hardware competition**

- Final Version 3.0 rules released on 1 November and published on the IEEE SoutheastCon website
- No rules changes will be made unless something is discovered that makes the competition unplayable

- **Software competition**

- Meeting scheduled with UCF Programming Team to understand extent of assistance that can be provided to the LOC software competition
- Backup plans are in place in case UCF Programming Team is unable to assist

- 37 papers successfully submitted to date
- 5 papers returned to authors due to double-blind errors and can be resubmitted
- 14 papers accepted
- 4 papers rejected
- 2 withdrawn

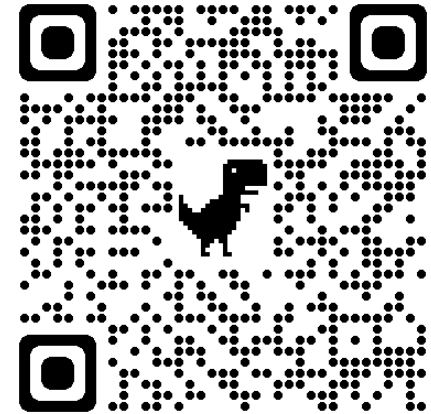
