Daniel W. Jackson Award

Purpose: To recognize a <u>Past Director</u> who, through continuing service to the Region and to the Institute, has made exemplary contributions to the electrotechnology profession.

Joseph M. Biedenbach Outstanding Engineering Educator Award

Purpose: To recognize a member of Region 3 who has shared technical and professional abilities through <u>teaching in industry</u>, government, or in an institution of higher learning and in so doing has made an outstanding contribution to the electrotechnology profession.

Outstanding Engineer Award

Purpose: To recognize a member of Region 3 who, through <u>technical</u> and professional abilities, has made an outstanding contribution to the electrotechnology profession.



Outstanding Service Award

Purpose: To recognize a member of Region 3 who, through <u>service</u> to the <u>Region</u> and the Institute, has made an outstanding contribution to the electrotechnology profession.

Professional Leadership Award

Purpose: To recognize a member of Region 3 for <u>outstanding leadership efforts</u> in achieving the <u>professional</u> [economic, ethical, legislative, social] aims of IEEE in the United States.

Employer Professional Development Award

Purpose: To recognize an <u>employer in Region 3</u> for outstanding contributions in advancing the <u>professional development</u> of employees.



Exemplary Section Award

Purpose: To recognize outstanding <u>Section</u> leadership, management, and administration for the immediate past Section year. To provide a mechanism that allows the Regional Director to visit, recognize the Section leadership and make the award presentation.

Exemplary Student Branch Award

Purpose: To encourage though public recognition exemplary <u>Student Branch</u> operation.

Student Professional Activities Service Award

Purpose: To recognize <u>Student Branch and/or student member specific achievements and efforts in advancing the professional aims of IEEE in Region 3.</u>



Outstanding Young Professional Award

Purpose: To promote, recognize and support contributions from <u>young professional</u> members within IEEE Region 3. This award recognizes <u>leadership</u> in service, education, innovation, entrepreneurship or in furthering the goals of the IEEE Young Professionals.

Outstanding Education Activities Chair Award

Purpose: To promote and recognize <u>leadership</u> in service, education, innovation, entrepreneurship or in furthering the goals of the IEEE Educational Activities in Sections. Eligible candidates must be IEEE <u>Sections' Education Activity Committee Chairs (or equivalent role)</u> in Region 3 at the time of the nomination deadline.
