- Budget approved by Fincom, Conf Comm, R3 Excom, R3 Committee
- Budget submitted to IEEE Conference Finance and CB/NextGen account submitted have requested loans this week
- Call for papers released in Atlanta
- HW rules released in Atlanta
- SW, Circuit design started
- Review of contract and space for planning
- Contributor/Exhibitor "sales brochure" completed
 - First Contributor/Exhibitor secured!
- Approached Concord CVB for possible services was deemed too late as contract already signed
- Website design started
 - goal is to be ready for switchover on April 30
 - Will include galleries, competition results for 2024



Plans

- Still recruiting some positions
- Will be starting monthly Webex meetings later this month
- Planning retreat being considered for May
- Registration search in case any new alternatives have become available
 - Unless new vendor is found, RegFox and EDAS accounts to be set up by end-of-month and brought live by June 1, 2024
- Sponsors and Exhibitors are already being sought and acquired
 - Higher level contributors will be offered workshop/tutorial slots
 - Sources include companies who regularly attend UNC Charlotte job fairs and IEEE-HKN Student Leadership Conferences
 - Will also visit ASEE Annual Conference Exhibit Hall and "sell" to companies there
 - Will approach vendors at upcoming commercial design and manufacturing show in Charlotte in June
