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## **Conference Committee Report**

#### **Major Headlines**

- Met on July 9 and August 13 with the full committee
  - Status on closeout of SoutheastCon 2024
  - Status on planning and execution activities of SoutheastCon 2025 and 2026
  - Review of MOU for CaribCon joint conference with Region 9
- Completed a model RFP for hotels and conference space to be used by candidate OUs
  - Previous version was 1 page and did not have specific details
  - Current version is 12 pages and provides room specifications needed to run all three conference tracks
- Preparing a Proposal Guide for Candidate OUs to prepare proposal submissions
  - PowerPoint format so that it can be reused for other approvals (FinCom, ExCom, and R3 Committee)
  - Proposal template and content requirements for a successful proposal
  - Historical information (food and beverage, lodging rooms, conference room specifications)
  - Assumptions to use to build out budget so that proposals can be compared to each other
  - Target completion: September 14, 2024

### **Conference Committee Report**

#### Potential Candidate OUs for SoutheastCon 2027

- Received preliminary proposal from Jamaica Section as a candidate section for 2027
  - Reviewed offline and provided feedback to Jamaica Section on August 2
  - Answered feedback questions and provided additional verbal feedback on August 7
- Received notification from Daytona, Canaveral, Orlando, and Melbourne (DCOM) that they will be collaborating and submitting a joint proposal as a candidate OU for 2027 in Daytona Beach
  - Preparation materials sent to DCOM candidate OU team
- Spoke to David Livingston (Hampton Roads Section) regarding hosting SoutheastCon
  - Hampton Roads is in a rebuilding phase and will defer for now
