Area _3_- Strengths

- ► IEEE interest level has remained very steady in the last 4 years
- Membership in all sections has also remained steady
- ► Every year, we increase the cross sharing of events so that if not close by, all can join virtually
- ► We emphasize that non-technical presentations are also important; Investments, Insurance, Hurricane, medical and other social issues are encouraged
- Meetings are planned to be different and inviting to the members & community
- ► We have the advantage of belonging to the Florida Council who also supports our Sections
- ▶ We find that we have different types of member concentration: Industry dominant, University dominant and the lucky ones, a good mixture of both. To the best of my knowledge:
 - University dominant are: Daytona, Palm Beach, Broward, Miami
 - ► Industry + University are: Melbourne, Canaveral, FWC, Orlando

Area _3_- Weaknesses

- ► Most of the Area3 Sections have been performing very well
- ► The Area has suffered some setback in two Sections: Daytona & Palm Beach
 - ► Daytona Section Some setbacks were experienced in 2024 and the section went partly silent
 - ► Area3 Chair traveled to Daytona on March 13th and held a meeting to kick start the meetings
 - Several goals were set and currently working on those
 - ▶ Palm Beach Section has been having member issues for a while. I am also working closely with them to increase member participation and am talking directly with members to plan a couple of events
- Just discovered that some sections do not know about LISTSERV or ENOTICE
- ► The Balance of the sections in Area3 have been running smoothly for the past few years

Area _3_- Opportunities

- Work with each section to present their recent accomplishments and successes. Offer suggestions & examples
- Mutual growth and health of the sections a priority, time and schedule coordination must be priority for the section so as to work together
- ► Area3 Chair is available to schedule virtual or in person meetings at each section local
- ► Follow up with each Area3 Section to ensure that they have a group emailing list: Listserv or Enotice
- ► All Florida Sections have the opportunity to and do attend the Florida Council Quarterly Meetings

Area _3_- Threats

- ► The largest threat to our Area is that the year goes faster than there is time to schedule meetings both locally and with Area3 Chair or joint section meetings
- ► As noted, all Area Sections are proactive and willing to work together
- ► Limited section budgets also prevent more and better meetings to attract members
