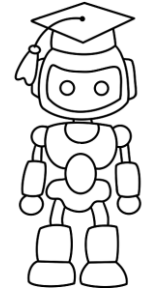

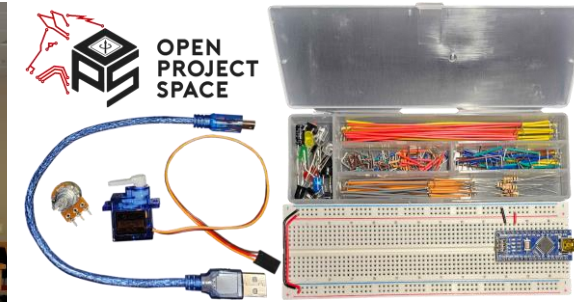
ENCS Section Report- 2025 Major Successes



1. National Engineers Week:

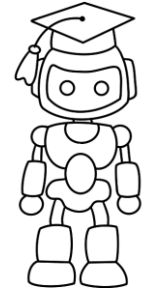


2. Open Projects Space(Fall 2024- Current):
