

- “Communication for All” Call for Project Proposals launched on 15 May
 - *3rd edition of the collaboration, but this year has a new name (used to be “Internet for All”)*
- The Digital Divide persists as one of the main challenges of our digital era with more than 33% of the world’s population still unconnected. By prioritizing the expansion of connectivity and the enhancement of infrastructure, communications engineers can play a pivotal role in bridging this gap and fostering socio-economic development in underserved communities.
- Open to active IEEE and ComSoc Members; teams will likely be ComSoc Chapters
- Applicants must propose a connectivity project with a selected focus area:
 - Agricultural Technology ([SDG 2: Zero Hunger](#))
 - Technology to promote Healthy Lives and Well-being ([SDG 3: Good Health and Well-Being](#))
 - Technology to Improve Education ([SDG 4: Quality Education](#))
 - Technology to promote Gender Equality ([SDG 5: Gender Equality](#))

- Call for Project Proposals launched on 15 May
- Collaboration between Tech4Good and the IEEE Electron Devices Society (EDS) is a unique opportunity for EDS members to use their skillset and expertise to apply technology for social impact.
 - Technology within EDS fields of interest
- Open to active IEEE and EDS Members; teams will likely be EDS Chapters
- Applicants must select a focus area:
 - **Agricultural technology (SDG 2)**
 - **Clean water technology (SDG 6)**
 - **Affordable and clean energy (SDG 7)**

HT Opportunities

- Event Sponsorship - HTB Events funding enables **IEEE organizational units (OUs)** to contribute to one or more of the HTB strategic pillars through conferences and events around the world.
 - The proposal should make clear how HT would be engaged in the event, such as time for a keynote, workshop or similar, in exchange for its sponsorship.
 - Four levels of sponsorship (\$500 - \$10,000)
