Below is LM Coordinator's report / SSC for R3 ExCom on September 22, 2025.

1. Activities Since Last Report

(a) New LMAG Formation:

Formed six new LMAGs in 2025: Richmond VA (Gokul Pandy); Virginia Mountain (Bala Mani); Central Savannah River SC (Annette Burney); Central TN (Sidney Hamby); Chattanooga TN (LMAG Chair - Jeff Nelson); Evansville-Owensboro IN (Jacob Alebiosu)

New LMAG Petitioned in 2025 (in formation life cycle): Gainesville FL (Eric Schwartz on September 19, 2025). With this LMAG petition approved, R3 will have 35 LMAGs out of 41 Sections.

(b) Guidance for all LMAGs on LM activities and posting in v-Tool events:

Ensured all the new LMAGs formed in 2025 posted activities in v-Tools to qualify for Sections for rebates in 2026on account of LMAG events.

Ensured all LMAGs of R3 engaged in 2025 activities and posted in v-Tools to qualify for the Sections for rebates in 2026 on account of LMAG events and satisfy goals and requirements of MGA to remain successful LMAGs.

Ensured that IEEE HKN International Leadership Conference chaired by Jim Conrad (Charlotte NC LMAG) with cooperation of Charlotte Section Chair Pankaj Bhaumik qualified for LMC Sponsorship for event in Ann Arbor, Michigan in November 2025.
