#### **GOLD Members Selection Criteria**

#### Criteria to select the GOLD members as a delegates to the GOLD Summit:

#### Requirements (not a must, but preferable)

- Never been to an international/Regional meeting, or the past Section Congress
- Potential IEEE future leader with good leadership and management skills
- Knowledge of the local GOLD Affinity Group operation
- Interesting to create New GOLD Affinity group
- Strong communications and networking skills
- Great personality, friendly, self-motivate, eager to learn
- Someone who has experience on online communities is a plus

#### **Duties:**

- Actively participate on the discussion and brain storming sessions at GOLD Summit
- Communicate with their local Sections and GOLD Affinity Groups for idea and suggestions

#### Rewards:

- Increased understanding of IEEE operations not only regional activities but Society
- Interaction with IEEE volunteers with different background
- Leave GOLD volunteers from around the world with inspiring ideas
- Interact and network with IEEE leaders, and share with them their ideas and problems
- Get advises on how to handle their issues base on IEEE leader's vast experience, and return back to local activities
