CCECE Organizers are pleased to announce a Student Paper Competition Award. Up to six such awards may be given subject to the following conditions:

1. The student must be first author of an accepted paper and must be nominated by the supervisor by way of 15 to 20 sentence rationale as to why the paper merits consideration.
2. Nominated papers that received high evaluations score during the initial evaluation will be read by a couple of researchers and scored on their complete manuscript as it appears in the Conference Proceedings.
3. Winning papers will receive a certificate from the conference during the luncheon on Wednesday 25 April 2007 in the Grand Ballroom.
4. Authors of winning papers must be willing to submit their paper for publication in the Canadian Journal of Electrical and Computer engineering
