Speaker for the session was Ramyasri Ramaraju, IEEE MVSR SB Chair, REM Scholar for 2019 cycle.

Speaker started the session by explaining the REM Aspirants what are the awards under IEEE that are applicable for IEEE members and thereby she explained what are the benefits of REM scholarship, it's eligibility, how to apply.

She said that the Merwin scholarship now has two application deadlines: 30 April and 30 September of each year and one may apply once per year.

She acknowledged that graduate students, and those in the final two years of an undergraduate program with IEEE Computer Society membership for at least three (3) months prior to the application deadline is required. She said that the applicants are required to have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 / 4.0 (or exam marks of at least 60%), and be a full-time student as defined by his or her academic institution during the course of the award and also student winners of the Computer Society's Richard Merwin or UPE/CS award for the previous year (13 months) are not eligible.



IEEE CS REM Help desk

She explained what are to be attached along the application like, academic transcripts, LOR's. She briefed about the things which are not to included, benefits of REM scholarship and also about other awards of IEEE CS like upsilon pi epsilon.

She shared the IEEE leadership roles, her personal journey in the IEEE so far and her experience and also about the student ambassador vision. She concluded the session by clarifying the doubts raised by the attendees.
