

Hari Krishna, Student Branch Counsellor, IEEE MVSR SB to address the gathering. Later he addressed the session and invited Mrs. B. Saritha, IEEE CS Student Branch Advisor to address the meeting.

Then, Ms. M. Shresta Reddy has introduced the speaker Mr. G. Rajesh Kumar who is the Student Network Team Mentor, IEEE Hyderabad Section, YP Coordination Team Member, IEEE India Council Founder and President Eternal Hearts of Humanity and handed over the session to him.

The speaker has begun the session by introducing himself to the gathering and spoke about how he was benefitted by IEEE membership and its programs. Further, he gave details on what IEEEExtreme is and how to participate in its contests.

Ms. N. Sai Divya has taken over the session and shared her experience in the previous contests of IEEEEXTreme which are IEEEEXTreme 12.0 and 13.0. She stated how these competitions were useful to her to compete with the global programming network in this highly competitive world.

Later, she mentioned the dates to be noted down for IEEEEXTreme 14.0. She also briefed the benefits of becoming an IEEEEXTreme ambassador and the role of it. She insisted and encouraged everyone should take part in the contest which builds up their self-confidence to compete with the world. She has also spoken about the changes in the rules of the contest.
