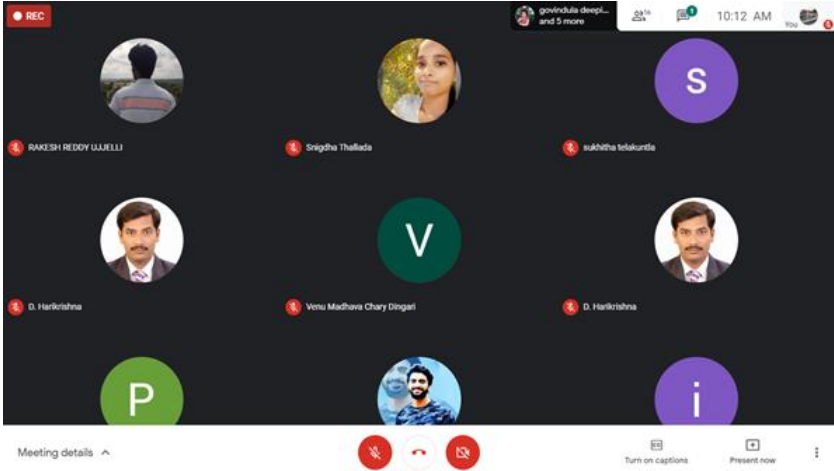

Later, Ms. Nikita, Chairperson, PES Student Chapter, has listed out the rules and regulations to be followed while attempting the quiz. They are as follows:

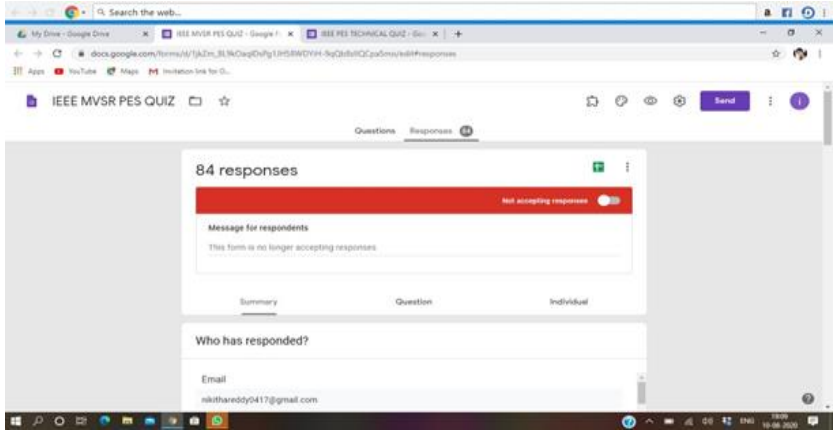
- 1) The quiz link will be mailed to the participant's mail address and the link will also be posted in the group.
- 2) The quiz link will remain active till 4 PM, after which no more responses will be encouraged.
- 3) E-Certificate will be provided to the participants who are able to score above 60%.
- 4) If any participant is found engaging in malpractice, his/her response will not be considered.

Followed by this, Dr. D. Venumadhava Chary addressed the session. He has appreciated the PES Student Chapter for undertaking this activity and keeping the students engaged during these unprecedented times. He has urged the organizers to conduct activities like this on a large scale and assured them assistance from the EEE Department. 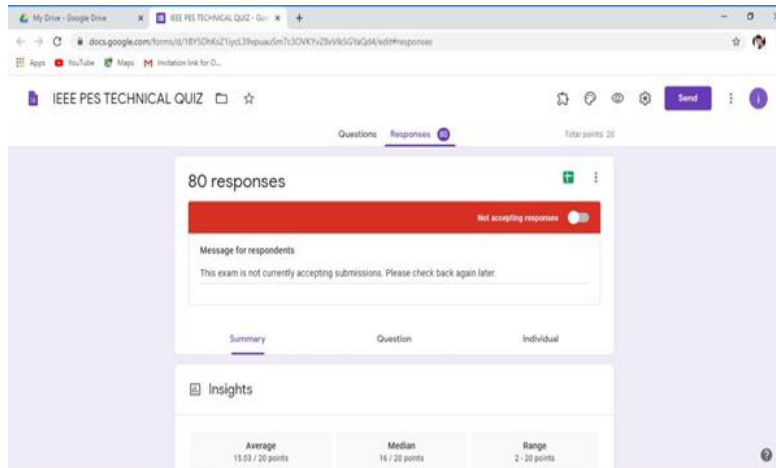


Glimpse from inaugural session

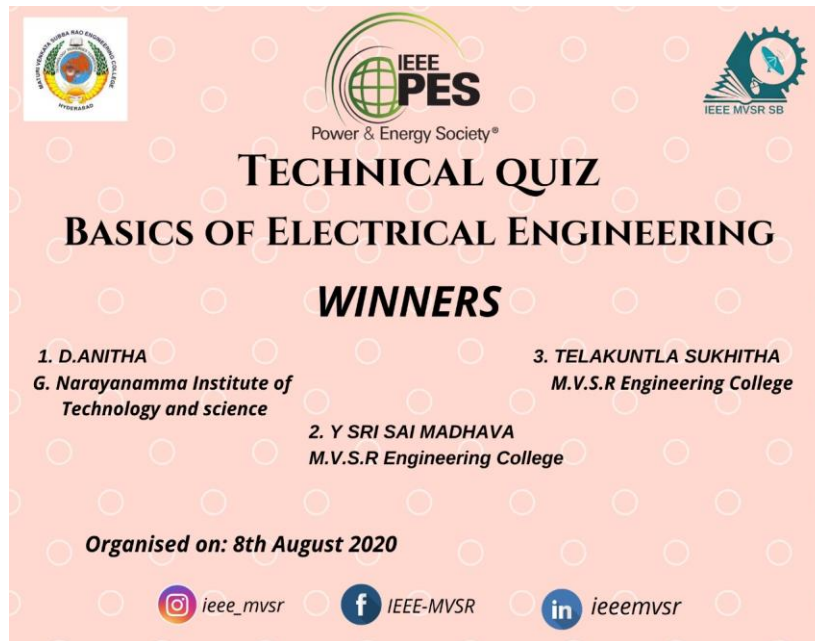


Total Number of registrations

The event went ahead as per the schedule. As the flexibility of choosing the time window is provided to the participants, the event went ahead smoothly. The level of complexity is kept moderate as the target audience were first-year students. Participants followed all the aforementioned rules and regulations and participated in the event enthusiastically. A total of 84 registrations out of which eighty (80) have filed in their responses. Out of the eighty (80) participants, sixty-seven (67) of them were able to secure above sixty percent (60 %).
