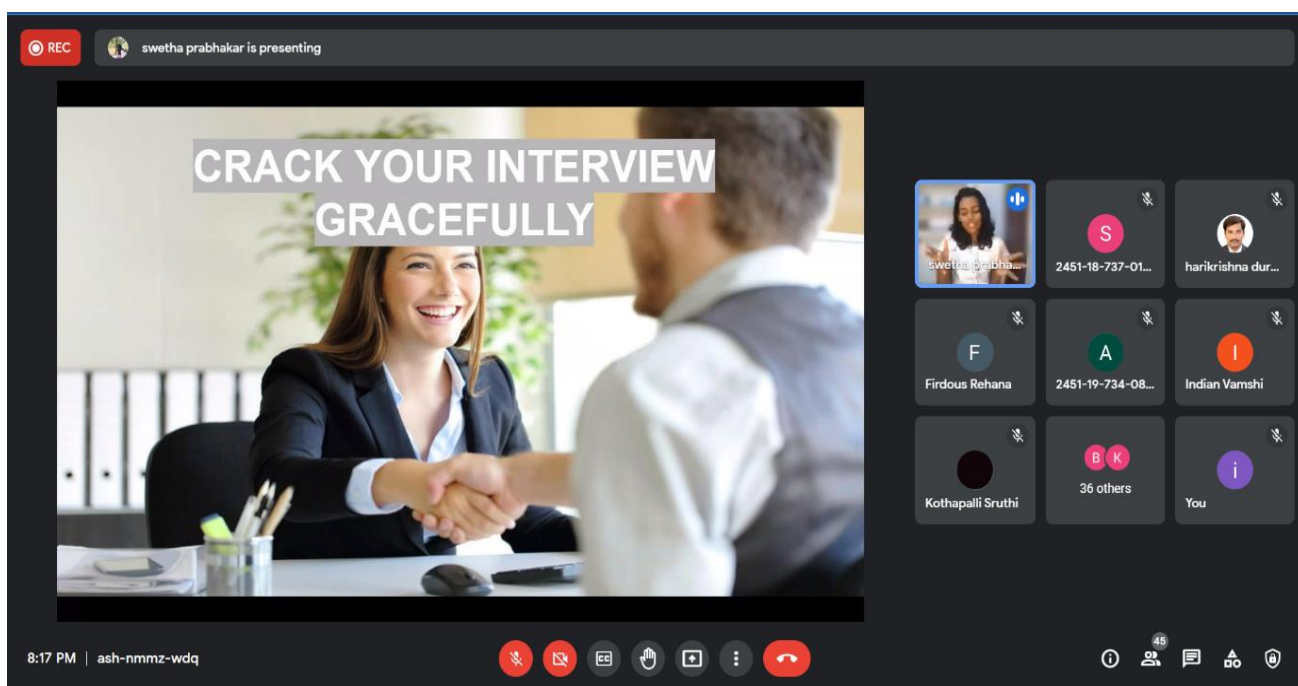

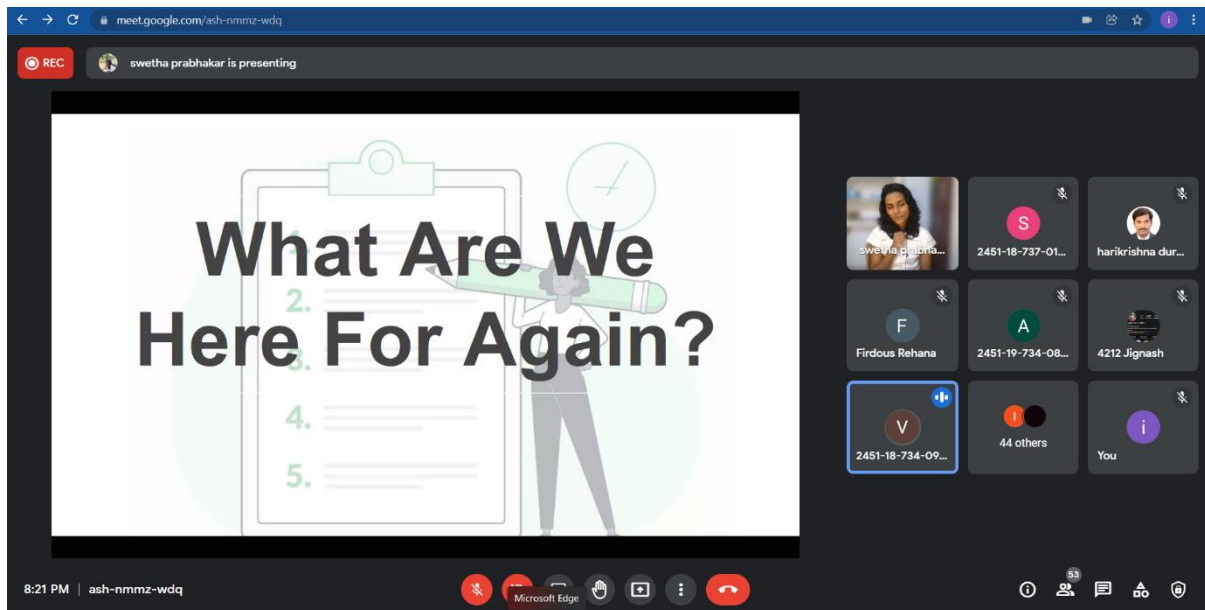

Ms. Swetha Prabhakar has began the session by thanking IEEE MVSR SB for providing this opportunity and appreciated the co-ordinators of the event. The speaker started the webinar by saying that "What Are We Here For Again", explained that this is the time now where we have to learn some interview skills which will help us in the future.

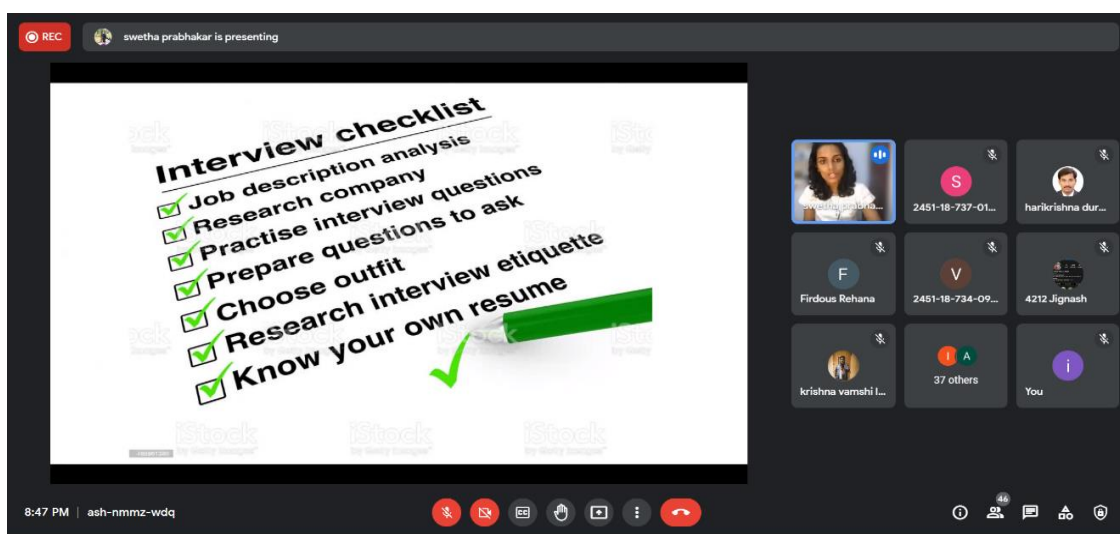


Speaker explaining about “What Are We Here For Again?” during the session

She said that, there are three stages to prepare for an interview. The three stages include Pre-Interview, During Interview and Post Interview. The Pre-Interview preparation includes Research, Appearance, Prepare Questions. These will help one to relax and understand his/ her role in the company. Then, she asked one of the students to tell them about themselves. This made students interact with the speaker and learn how to present themselves formally.

Later, she explained how Men and Women should be dressed for the interview purpose and how a checklist should be made that would help us boost our skills and will help to give interviews successfully.

She said that, the Interview Checklist includes Job Description Analysis, Research about the company, Practise interview questions, Prepare questions to ask during the interview, Choose correct outfit, Research Interview Etiquette and Know one’s own resume.

Men:

- Dress Shirts:**
 - solid colors, preferably white
 - long-sleeved, tucked in, and buttoned all the way up
 - wear an undershirt
- Tie:**
 - Conservative pattern
 - Hang to belt line
- Belt:**
 - Leather – match color and finish of shoes, small buckle
- Socks and Dress Shoes:**
 - Dark colors that match attire (no white socks)
 - Over the calf, so no skin is ever visible
 - Shine shoes (no scuff marks)

Women:

- Blouse:**
 - Solid color or white
- Suits:**
 - Keep skirt within 3 inches of knees
- Makeup:**
 - Conservative and natural looking – less is more
- Nails:**
 - Neutral polish or none at all
 - Remove cracked or peeling polish
- Hosiery/Socks:**
 - Flesh toned nylons or dark trouser socks
 - No “runs”
 - Required with skirts
- Shoes:**
 - 1-2 inch heel or nice flats (no open toe)
 - Match color to outfit

Then, she explained that basic steps are required to prepare for an interview. We should dress appropriately, arrive in good time, have correct body language, expect the unexpected, ask questions. These are the basic steps required in the interview (Pre, During, Post).

Then, she said that, after giving the interview, one must evaluate their interview on what went well and what went wrong, contact your references and discuss about what they expect from the potential employer, send a follow up letter thanking the interviewer restating your enthusiasm for the job opportunity, carry on your job search for your better opportunities.

Later, the speaker cleared the doubts raised by the attendees. And then speaker concluded her webinar by saying thank you to all the members present in the meeting.
