



Dr D. Hari Krishna Commencing the Membership Drive




Dr D. Hari Krishna presenting the IEEE Motto




Awards & Accolades received by IEEE MVSR SB




Events and Workshops organised by IEEE MVSR SB and its Student Chapters




PES Student Chapter Inaugural




Scholarships Awarded to Student Members of IEEE MVSR SB
