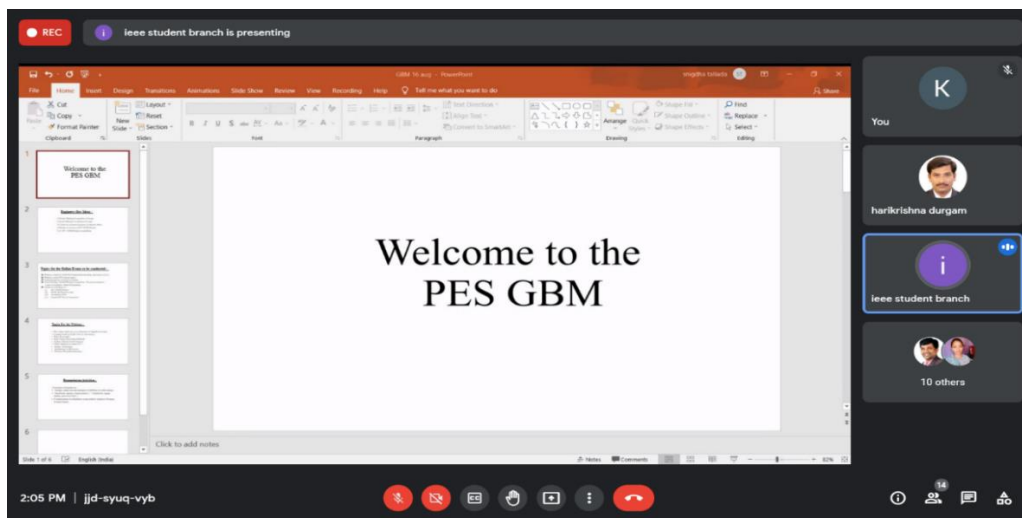

He later requested Mr. Narasimha Swamy to address the meet. Mr. Narasimha Swamy greeted everyone and thanked for inviting him to the meet, later he called for collective work under Dr D. Hari Krishna.

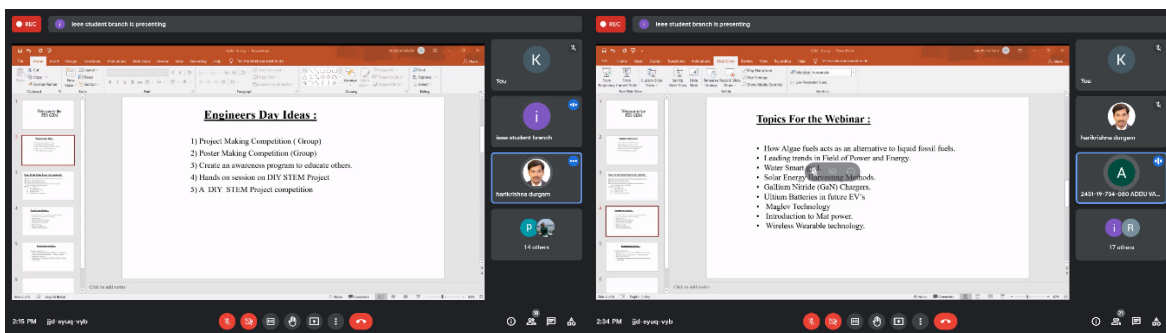
Followed by this, Dr Hari Krishna invited the newly elected ExCom members to introduce themselves to the attendees. All the PES ExCom members, followed by Mr. Surya Teja, IEEE MVSR SB Secretary, Ms. Sai Sri, Vice Chair, IEEE MVSR WIE, Ms. Phani Priya, Program Committee, IEEE MVSR SB and Mr. Krishna Chaitanya, Publicity Committee, IEEE MVSR SB introduced themselves.

Later, the attendees were notified about the offer running regarding the IEEE membership. Anyone who is willing to join IEEE can avail this offer and get a membership till next year December. He further mentioned that the current membership count of IEEE MVSR student branch is 78 on contrary to the usual annual average of 120+ memberships, he also brought to the notice of attendees that chapter subscription is optional, and an IEEE member can subscribe to any chapter irrespective of their branch.

Dr D Hari Krishna advised IEEE members to explore IEEE website for IEEE digital library and IEEE spectrum and utilize the resources. He also advised ExCom to create awareness on the benefits of IEEE through poster, videos etc.

Later, Ms. Snigdha, IEEE MVSR SB PES Student Chapter Chairperson briefed the panel about the action plan which needs to be followed and listed out some events. She suggested to conduct Membership Drive and Workshop on ‘DIY Stem Project and suggested campaigning to enlighten young minds regarding energy conservation and later suggested to conduct Logo Competition and Model Making Competition.

She continued by suggesting that collaborative events with local PES Section Chapter, local YP, WIE and CASS, PES SB Chapters can be conducted. She later called upon ExCom members to present their ideas. All the executive committee members seized on this opportunity and have put forth their suggestions.

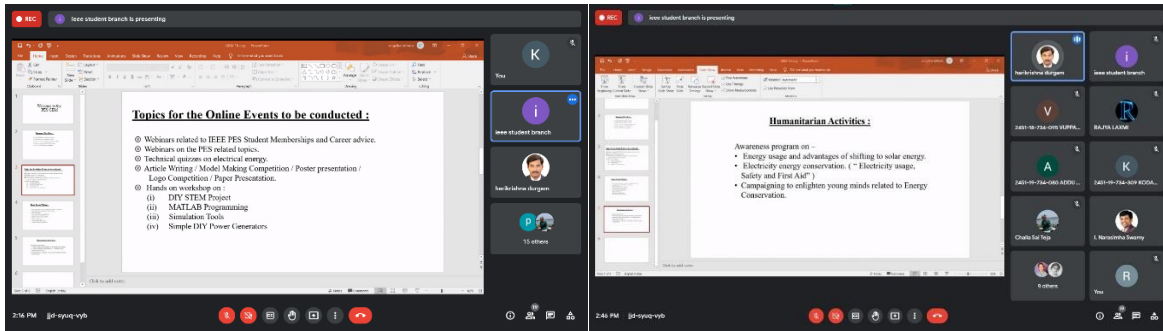


Topics proposed

Mr. V. Vivek, Vice Chair, IEEE MVSR SB PES Chapter, suggested, conducting webinars on Career Guidance by Alumni and conducting workshops on ‘How to write Research Paper’, ‘Simulation Tools’ & ‘Circuit Modelling’ would be beneficial for members. He also suggested to conduct awareness programme on optimal energy usage and advantages of shifting to solar power.

Mr. K. Naga Seshu, Secretary, IEEE MVSR SB PES Chapter, proposed the idea of conducting webinars on numerous topics, some of the notable topics were ‘Wireless Wearable Tech’, ‘Artificial Sun’, ‘Solar Energy Harvesting’ and ‘Applications of Digital Technology in Pandemic’. He also suggested to conduct article writing competition on topics related to Electric vehicles, Renewable sources. Quizzes, Project expo and Poster presentation can also be organised.

Mr. Rama Ankith, Joint Secretary, IEEE MVSR SB PES Chapter, came up with the idea of conducting webinars on the topics ‘Gallium Nitride Chargers’, ‘Ultium Battery System’, ‘Maglev Technology’ and also suggested to conduct workshop on ‘Simple DIY Power Generators’.

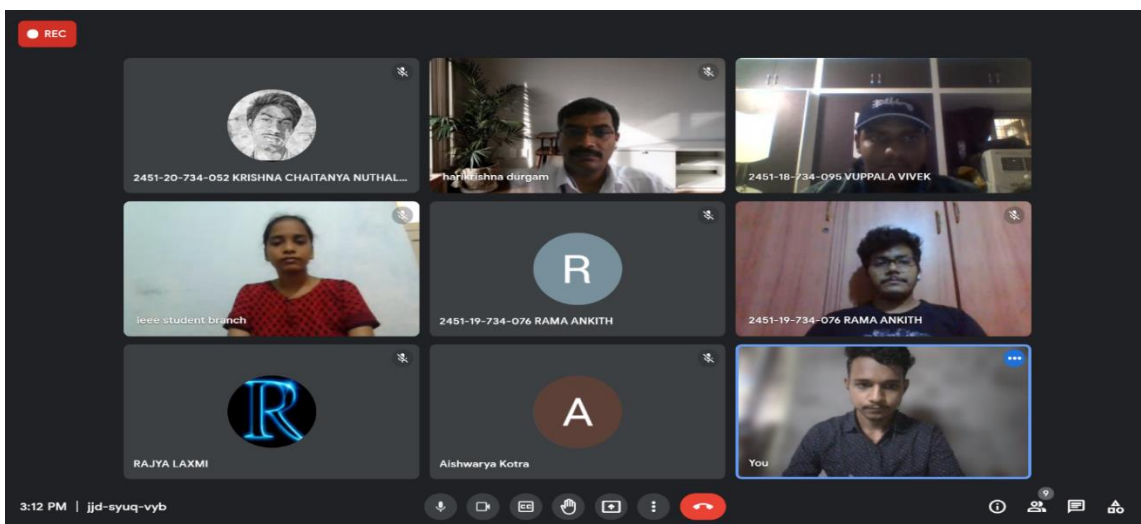


Topics listed for Workshops & Humanitarian Activities
