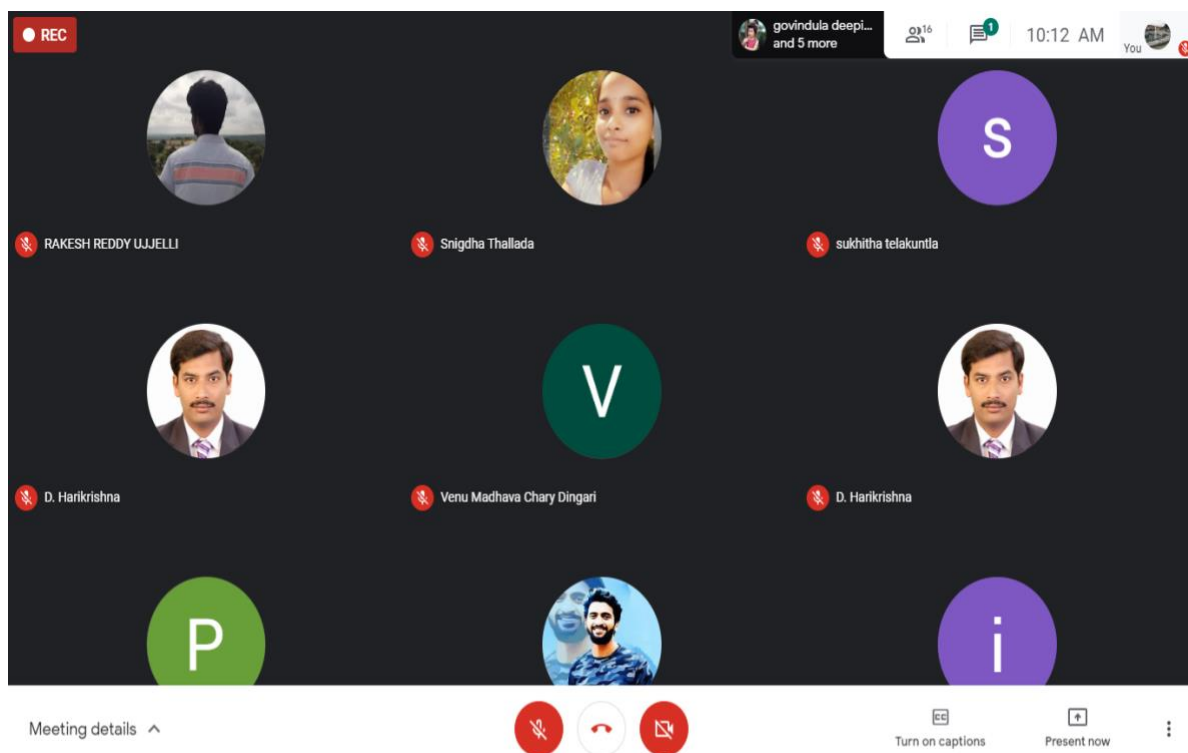

- 4) If any participant is found engaging in malpractice, his/her response will not be considered.

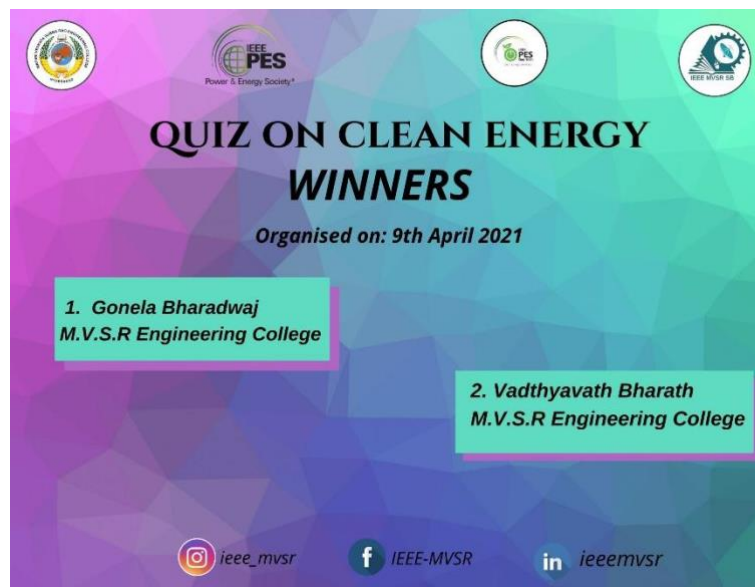
