



She is also an IEEE Young Professional and held the role of IEEE MVSR Student Branch Chairperson for year 2018-2019. Ms Ramyasri congratulated the ExCom members and wished them luck to organise numerous events and bag awards. She then explained the roles and responsibilities of various ExCom positions. She began by explaining the duties of Chairperson. His responsibilities include preside over the meetings, maintain memberships, have proper lists of all events, vTools reporting and to oversee that all ExCom members are attending the general body meetings. She termed Chairperson as the brain of the student branch and chapters.

Followed by this Ms. Ramyasri explained about the responsibilities of Vice Chairperson. Obligations of Secretaries and Joint Secretaries were described next. Main duties include drafting event reports and to keep detailed minutes of meeting. She labelled the role of secretary as an important one as the reports act as a testament of a particular event. Treasurer and Women in Computing, Women in Power responsibilities were also explained. Treasurers were given an additional responsibility of exploring various awards and notifying the details about them to the IEEE members. Foremost duty of women in power and women in computing are to explore magazines and make their fellow IEEE members aware of the recent trends in technology and to organise events in collaboration with WIE Affinity Group.
