It is required that the first author is a Tokyo Tech student. Papers must be written in English. Papers submitted for review to a journal or to a conference but not yet accepted in the journal or presented in the conference are eligible. The articles can be on any engineering subject in the field of interest of IEEE, including but not limited by the following:

- **Electromagnetics and Radiation**
- **Computer**
- **Engineering and Human**
- **Energy and Power Engineering**
- **Signal and Applications**
- **Systems and Control**
