- 6. Upon acceptance, an IEEE Transfer of Copyright Form must be completed by the authors and submitted as an additional camera-ready file on the CMT website
- 7. Register for the Conference: Each accepted paper must have at least one author at the full registration fee.

Submission Guidelines:

The submission must adhere to the IEEE guidelines elaborated below. The submission must include the title, authors' names, affiliations, and contact. IEEE recommended Word and Latex templates are provided at:

http://www.ieee.org/conferences events/conferences/publishing/templates.html

LENGTH: Documents are limited to 4 pages, including all figures, tables, and references.

PAPER SIZE: Documents should be formatted for standard US letter-size (8-1/2" by 11") pages.

- All text and figures must be contained in a 175 mm x 226 mm (6.9 inch x 8.9 inch) image area.
- The left and right margins must be 0.63 inch.
- The top margin must be 0.75 inch
- The bottom margin must be 1 inch
- Text should appear in two columns, each 3.5 inch wide with 0.25 inch space between columns.

TYPEFACE: We strongly encourage authors to use Times-Roman font. If a font face is used that is not recognized by the submission system, your proposal will not be reproduced correctly.

> Paper Title: 24 point Author's names: 11 point Author's affiliation: 10-point

Abstract: 9-point

Body of the document: 10-point Figure and table captions: 8-point font.


References list: 8-point font.

TITLE: The title should follow the MS word template format. The authors' name(s) and affiliation(s) appear below the title in capital and lower case letters. Submissions with multiple authors and affiliations may require two or more lines for this information.

ABSTRACT: Each paper should contain an abstract of no more than 2000 characters at the beginning of the document. Use the same text that is submitted electronically along with the author contact information.

BODY: Major headings appear in boldface CAPITAL letters, centered in the column. Subheadings appear in capital and lower case, either underlined or in boldface. They start at the left margin of the column on a separate line. Sub-subheadings are discouraged, but if they must be used, they should appear in capital and lower case. and start at the left margin on a separate line. They may be underlined or in italics.

ILLUSTRATIONS: Axes/Labels/Text in the illustrations must be clearly readable. Please use suitable graphic editors to generate clear figures.



UNACCEPTABLE FIGURE

Illustrations must typically appear within the designated margins. For illustrations spanning both columns, please position them at the top of the page, or at the bottom. Caption and number every illustration. All halftone illustrations must be clear in black and white. Since the printed proceedings will be produced in black and white, be sure that your images are acceptable when printed in black and white.

PAGE NUMBERS: Do not put page numbers on your document. We will add appropriate page numbers to accepted papers in the conference proceedings.

FILENAME:

The filename of the document file should format: the DCAS14 LASTNAMEofAuthor1 FIRSTNAMEofAuthor1 VERSION#.pdf

For example, if the first author's name is John Doe, you would submit your file as "DCAS14 Doe John 1.pdf"

The review process will be performed from the electronic submission of your paper. To ensure that your document is compatible with the review system, please adhere to the following compatibility requirements:

PDF files must not have Adobe Document Protection enabled, as this prevents us from processing the file. These submissions must be formatted to 8.5" x 11" page size, and in first-page-first order. Please verify that the final version of your PDF file prints correctly to a PostScript printer before submission. Documents that do not print correctly cannot be reviewed. Also, make sure to disable ALL document security. For best results, authors should avoid the use of custom half tones, bitmap pattern fills, and bitmap fonts. Use standard half tones and solid color or grey fills instead. If you are able to create a PDF file yourself, you are encouraged to do so. Be sure that you embed all fonts that are used when you create the PDF file.
