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You should also understand that at least one of the paper's authors must register for the conference at either a full or one-day member (or non-member) rate by no later than June 15, 2006. If a student is the ONLY registering author, then that student must register with a full or one-day regular registration, NOT a student registration. If another author of the paper is registered for the conference at a regular (non-student) rate, then any student co-authors may use a student registration even if he or she will be presenting the paper. A registration confirmation number will be required to upload your paper, so an appropriate conference registration should be completed by June 15, 2006 before starting the paper upload process.

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Instructions for the preparation and submission of your paper, registering for the conference, making a hotel reservation, and other details will be available on the conference web site (<http://www.ieee.org/ias2006>) on or about May 15, 2006. Note that the web link for author instructions will lead to all relevant information and instructions for preparing your paper, including templates for formatting, and you are encouraged to review the information on the upload site prior to actually beginning the upload process.
