Fly fishing is a distinct and ancient angling method offering a unique challenge and great enjoyment for both the experienced and novice fisherman or fisherwoman. The sport came here from England. In the United States it started in New York and grew down the Southern Appalachian mountains then eventually to the West. But fly fishing is more than a sport. It is a tradition that tantalizes the imagination and urges you to learn more. People who fly fish are thinkers, they read and they enjoy the outdoors.





Tennessee offers some of the best fly fishing around. Little River is one of the largest and most diverse streams in the Smoky Mountains. Fly anglers can target smallmouth in the lowest sections, rainbow and brown trout in the middle sections, and brook trout in the upper reaches. The National Park does not stock the rivers; wild rainbow, brown and brook trout are ready to test your skills.

The day starts early and includes transportation from the Convention Center. We travel to Townsend, the Peaceful Side of the Smokies to Little River Outfitters for instruction on fly tying and fly fishing taught by experienced professionals. Then we take our newly found or newly honed skills to the ultimate proving ground – Little River. Tennessee fishing license, fishing equipment and lunch will be provided. Guests may bring their own equipment if they prefer.
