Over a six-year period, an entire community of craftsmen worked to build the country's premier home. The estate boasted its own brick factory, woodworking shop, and a three-mile railway spur for transporting materials to the site.

We travel to Asheville, NC to visit the spectacular home of George Vanderbilt. The home, built on 8,000 acres of land has more then 250 rooms open to the public. On this self guided tour you will see the stunning elegance the family, their servants and retainers lived in during the Gilded Age in America. Enjoy the beautiful gardens and landscaping designed by Olmstead Law, see the farm that continues to raise food for the estate, and enjoy visiting the Biltmore Winery. Lunch is included in this day long journey back in time.
