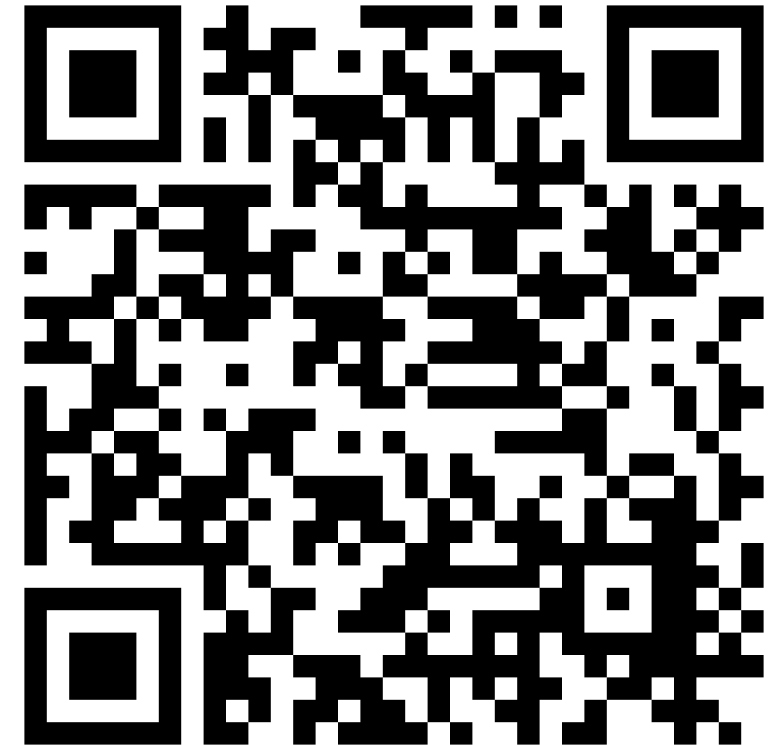

Scope includes:

- Automatic reclosers and sectionalizers
- Current limiting devices
- Fuses and cutouts
- Gas-insulated switchgear
- Insulation, insulators and hardware for switchgear
- Metal-enclosed buses & all buses included in switchgear assemblies
- Power circuit breakers
- Switches, including pad-mounted switches
- Switchgear assemblies
- Switchgear devices

#3: Publish Papers and TECHNICAL REPORTS

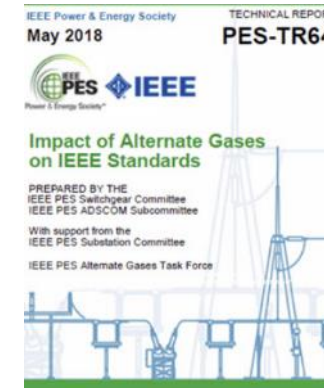
