### **Meeting Minutes**

#### 1. Call to order and introduction:

- Meeting was called to order at 8:00 AM.
- The chair notified the group that members who have missed two consecutive meetings will be dropped from membership. They can ask to be reinstated if desired. The chair will email notification to these (9) people.
- Roster sheet was started and each person introduced themselves and identified their affiliation.

#### 2. IEEE Patent Slides:

- All four standard IEEE patent slides displayed
- Time was allowed for members to respond. No comments were received after the time was provided.

#### 3. Roster Check:

• (34) Attendees, of which (17) are members. There are (27) members after the (9) had been dropped.

#### 4. Previous Meeting Minutes:

• Meeting notes were published in PES switchgear minutes after the spring. There were no comments regarding the published minutes.

#### 5. Meeting Highlights:

- Discussed status of the balloting. The ballot is still open.
  - There was question about copyright issues with C37.60 since that was the origin of much of the wording. That has been resolved by the IEEE and the chair. There are no issues.
  - o Ballot opened Sept 25 and will close Oct 25.
  - As of now 113 comments, 24 need to be satisfied. 81 people in the pool, 35 votes in, and
    27 affirmative with 5 negatives.
- The comments have (5) categories of
  - 1. Editorial Grammatical, punctuation, etc.
  - 2. Changing references from IEC 62271-1 to C37.100.1
  - 3. Changes to improve the image quality of figures
  - 4. Updated publication dates of referenced standards
  - 5. Other corrections to references

Rather than look at these individually, they are considered editorial comments and the WG gave approval for the Chair to make changes as he sees fit. All changes will be presented to the WG for their comment.

- 26 of the comments were discussed individually by the WG.
  - See comments spreadsheet for specific notes of what was discussed during the comment review.
  - Discussion was held on Table 9 duties. It was suggested that the 90% to 100% Rated symmetrical interrupting current range for the T100 duty be changed to a tolerance of 0 to +5%, i.e. 100% to 105%. Uzelac, Banninck, and Morton group will include this in their review of the short circuit test procedures of 7.103.4.2 and table 9.
  - o There is no tolerance table. Banninck, DeCesaro, will look at C37.60.
  - Annex C of C37.60 was normative. Why is it normative when it is an illustration for measurement. It basically gives you the two parameter method and should be informative.
    - Antone Bonner will look into this to see where it is referenced and whether it should stay normative.
    - It was pointed out that this is a valid method for drawing the envelope and that you can verify your wave shape meets the requirements.
  - Project time line was presented to the working group (see external file with minutes to review these)
