- v. C37.04 has a 2 second duration for short-circuit (Clause 5.8). This clause will need to be reviewed for harmonization.
- vi. Clause 6.3 If it is a cut-out mounted sectionalizer, the frame does not include a ground connection. Discussion on if they should be excluded.

1. P. Agliata to draft verbiage related to live tank devices.

- vii. Clause 6.4 Discussion on if control equipment requirements should be defined.
 - 1. One user believes that this should be expanded on, especially given the number of devices which have device-to-device communication.
 - 2. It was recommended that maybe the Integrated Controls section of 37.68 would be applicable.

3. P. Found to propose language for this clause.

- viii. Clause 6.5 Discussion on if there is new information which would lead to this clause being applicable.
- ix. Clause 6.6 Discussion on Stored Energy Operation and if there are new products/ information which would be beneficial to consider for this clause.
 - 1. Agreement to review other documents (C37.60) for possible inclusion.
 - 2. Discussed including language regarding labeling for the stored energy.
 - 3. M. Culhane to propose language for this clause as well as 6.7 and 6.8.
- x. Clause 6.13 was added from C37.68.
 - 1. It was recommended that C37.60's language may be a better fit.
 - 2. A. Sadhanala to review the C37.60 verbiage and propose language for C37.63.
- xi. Clause 6.13.4 through 6.17 needs to be reviewed to determine if IEEE C37.100.1 would be a better reference. **S. Pell agreed to review the appropriate documents.**
- xii. Discussion on if the 6.23 clauses should reference Enclosures (vs tanks) and use C37.75 instead of the C57.12 documents. **F. DeCesaro and K. Trost to review and propose language.**
- xiii. Discussion on Table 5 Can the test samples be combined to meet the list of required tests?
 - 1. The chair is seeking a volunteer to review the combinations in C37.62 and C37.60 and propose verbiage.
 - a. Post meeting note: Chris Borck of Eaton has agreed to be responsible for this task.
- xiv. Clause 7.3 If RIV is not required, should it be deleted from the standard?
 - 1. One user mentioned current issues with Radio Influence.
 - 2. C37.60 and C37.62 reference their respective common clauses and but state that it does not apply.
 - 3. Several users felt there are existing issues with this, including new installations.
 - 4. It was pointed out that the test was restricted to a narrow band around 1 MHz.
 - 5. Decision to reference common clauses as does not apply. F. DeCesaro to update.
- xv. Clause 7.12.2 needs to be updated due to reference to IEEE 1247. F. DeCesaro to update.
- xvi. Question Is there a test / reference to sectionalizing with a capacitor bank downstream?
 - 1. It was noted that Sectionalizers do not fault interrupter (load break only).
 - 2. Discussion on if it should be added in the switching tests clause(s).
 - 3. If a device is rated for capacitor switching, it should be noted by the manufacturer. **P.** Agliata to review standards and propose verbiage.

d. Request that all Actions are sent to the chair by the end of the year.
