5. Working Group, Task Force, Study Group & Ad Hoc Status Reports

a. C37.20.1 – IEEE Standard for Metal-Enclosed Low-Voltage (1000 Vac and below, 3200 Vdc and below) Power Circuit Breaker Switchgear Mike Lafond: Meeting minutes are provided. Verbal update of WG activities.

Lashing of cables was discussed. There may be a need to change the PAR to add indication that copyright material may be needed to address cable lashing. Mike Lafond made motion to update the PAR to indicate that copyright material may be needed. Seconded by Paul Barnhart. Approved by unanimous consent.

PAR expires 12-31-2024. Documents posted in iMeet Central. Actions for SA S/C Chair: No further action required.

b. C37.20.1 – Ad Hoc between C37.13 and C37.20.1 focused on temperature limits of circuit breakers inside switchgear enclosures

Keith Flowers: No activity since last meeting.

c. C37.20.1 – Ad Hoc to investigate use of cables for testing

Tom Hawkins: Use of cables for testing has been included with the work by the working group.

d. C37.20.2 – IEEE Standard for Metal-Clad Switchgear:

Michael Wactor: Minutes are provided. Verbal update of WG activities.

Recirculation ballot was completed and the document submitted to REVCOM. After submittal to REVCOM a possible wording issue was discovered concerning interlock. Michael Wactor made motion to request the document back from REVCOM to allow the

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working group to address the possible wording issue. Seconded by Paul Barnhart. Approved by unanimous consent.

- f. C37.20.4 IEEE Standard for Indoor AC Switches (1 kV-52 kV) for Use in Metal-Enclosed Switchgear

Bob Cohn: Minutes are provided. Verbal update of WG activities. Working to remove references to IEC 62271. Plan to go to ballot this year.

g. C37.20.6 - IEEE Standard for 4.76 kV to 48.3 kV Rated Ground and Test Devices Used in Enclosures

Ron Hartzel: Minutes are provided. Verbal update of WG activities. Acted on approximately half of the comments received. Will hold virtual meeting before the Fall 2022 meeting. Would like to bring content from C37.04 into C37.20.6. Agreement by Switchgear Committee Chair (Keith Flowers) of that plan.

PAR approved on 9-23-2021, expiration date of 12-31-2025.

h. C37.20.7 - IEEE Guide for Testing Switchgear Rated Up to 52 kV for Internal Arcing Faults

Dan Hrncir: Minutes are provided. Verbal update of WG activities. Acted on most of the comments received and reports from several ad hoc groups. Additional ad hoc groups created to address specific topics.

 i. C37.20.10 – IEEE Standard for Definitions for AC (52 kV and Below) and DC (3.2 kV and Below) Switchgear Assemblies

Dan Delfino: Minutes are provided. Verbal update of WG activities. PAR was approved 0n 12/8/2021. Began review of the document. Will create draft document for the Fall 2022 meeting.

j. C37.23 – IEEE Standard for Metal Enclosed Bus

Jared Hines: Minutes are provided. Verbal update of WG activities. Discussed updates to C37.20.2 and C37.20.3 and possible impact on C37.23. Those will be reviewed and incorporated (as needed) into a C37.23 draft for the Fall 2022 meeting. Seismic information for bus was discussed during the meeting. Significantly more information is needed before seismic requirements for bus can be developed. Bus may be installed in many configurations and that makes seismic requirements very complicated. Actions for SA S/C Chair: No further action required.

k. C37.24 – IEEE Guide for Evaluating the Effect of Solar Radiation on Outdoor Metal-Enclosed Switchgear

SASC conducted an online vote on the motion to approve the PAR for C37.24 using the Direct Vote Live System. We opened the ballot on January 10th and closed on January 25th. The results were 16 votes to approve, 1 abstained, 0 votes to disapprove. The motion carries and the PAR can be submitted to NESCOM for approval.

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Terry Woodyard: Minutes are provided. Verbal update of WG activities. Held first meeting this week. Created several ad hoc groups to address specific items. Will hold virtual meetings this summer to prepare for Fall 2022 meeting.

 C37.122.2 - IEEE Draft Guide for the Application of Gas Insulated Substations 1 kV to 52 kV (This is an ADSCOM document of interest to SA S/C members)

Eldridge Byron: Minutes to be provided to ADSCOM. Verbal update of WG activities. This is a joint sponsorship document with Substations Subcommittee with Substations Subcommittee being the primary sponsor. One ballot completed with 300+ comments, but many comments were from a single balloter and comments were not for C27.122.2. Another ballot planned for around May.
