5. Draft Review and Discussion

The chair explained that the IEC – IEEE rules conflict. The previous WG meeting concluded, and passed by vote, that the document would be sent to ballot unchanged in technical content. The intention is for the IEEE to ballot the standard, resolve comments and then send to IEC. The IEC review and ballot process is expected to take many months based on past history. The agreement with IEC by communication between the chair and IEC liaison is that the IEC will change their revision date to match that of IEEE, for this document only. There is a note in the IEC/IEEE Cooperation guide Clause 4.5 that requires both organizations to have the same closing date.

The chair explained that the intended next step is to complete the ballot process in IEEE first then send the document to IEC for ballot.

Steps forward: Check documents for references Submit document to MEC and form ballot pool, minimum duration of 30 days After MEC sends draft back and ballot pool is formed, can go to ballot Ballot duration is a minimum of 30 days Recirculation duration is a minimum of 10 days After re-circulation is completed submit to REVCOM and IEC (at this point IEC ballot process starts)

It is noted and acknowledged that if comments are received from IEC then IEEE WG must comment on them
