(1) Lab tours in Xi'an Jiaotong University and others;


(2) Tour to Shaanxi History Museum, a walk on the historical sites (City Wall, etc., tentative) in Xi'an.

• About Xi'an

Xi'an, once the largest city in the world, was the capital of 13 Chinese dynasties, and a strategic point on the fabled Silk Road. Today, Xi'an is famous for its wealth of historical sites and interesting attractions. Foremost among these is the burial site of Emperor Qin Shi Huang, with its astonishing display of massed terracotta warriors. First

unearthed in 1974, they are regarded as one of the most valuable archaeological discoveries ever made, with many perfectly preserved despite more than 2000 years of burial.

Xi'an is rich in other historical sites as well, including the remains of a Neolithic village at least 8000 years old; the Ming Dynasty city wall; a 7th century pagoda; and the Shaanxi Provincial Museum, which boasts one of the greatest collections of artifacts in all China. No visit to China is complete without including Xi'an and a stay of at least 3-4 days is recommended.
