Richard Millham holds a BA (Hons) from the University of Saskatchewan in Canada, MA from Sheffield Hallam University in Sheffield, England, MSc from the University of Abertay in Dundee, Scotland, and a PhD from De Montfort University in Leicester, England. He is a Chartered Engineer (UK), a Chartered Engineer Assessor, and Senior Member of IEEE. He is currently an Associate Professor at the Durban University of Technology, DUT after a career in both industry and academe in various countries. He is an adjunct professor of computer science at the University of Energy and Natural Resources in Ghana.

Prof Millham has published extensively in his research fields of software evolution, aspects of cloud computing with m-interaction, aspects of big data, social media, security, and creative computing. He serves as a peer reviewer for many prominent journals and is on the technical committees for many international conferences. He has served as a keynote/plenary speaker in South Africa, China, and India. He is an active member of SACAB that seeks external accreditation and international recognition, via the Seoul Accord, of computing curricula at South African tertiary institutions.
