## Call for Tutorials

MVA2017 will host tutorials that focus on new research directions of machine vision and applications. The tutorials will take place on Thursday, May 11, 2017. The expected duration of each tutorial is 2 hours. We invite proposals for tutorials from active researchers. The target audience has an interest in learning the trends in the machine vision technologies and developing application systems. Potential attendees may also be interested in how venture companies develop machine-vision-related products. The following are examples of the themes encouraged:

- Describing a coherent theme in the relevant area in machine vision, from overview to the practical usage of the latest method.
- Illustrating image recognition algorithms or tools and showing applications to new users.
- Introducing machine-vision-related products and applications, with the story behind the development process in a venture company (that is, if the lecturer is from a venture company).

We expect each tutorial to motivate audience members to try out the new approaches, providing them with fundamental knowledge to start their own projects.

## Submission Guidelines:

The proposal should be 3-5 pages in A4 paper and include the following information:

- Title
- Abstract
- Brief biography of the speaker
